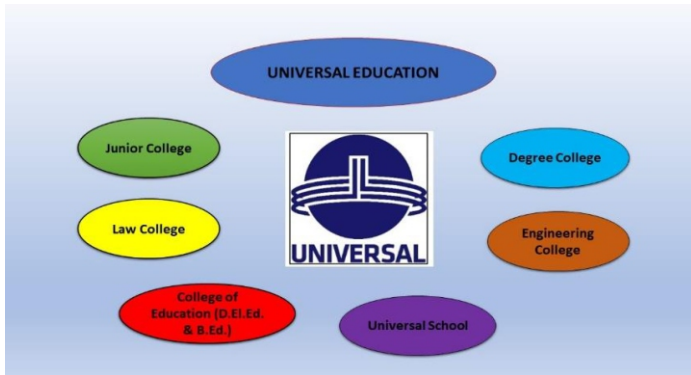

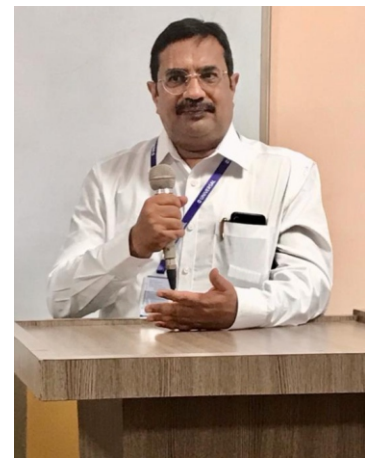

CRITERIA FOR GRANTING TERMS AND FOR PROMOTION <- MUST APPEAR AFTER THE EXAMINATION SCHEME AND BEFORE DISCIPLINARY ACTION

1. Students of F.Y.J.C. (Science) will not be promoted to S.Y.J.C. unless they fulfil the following conditions:

- Attend at least 75% of the lectures, practical and tutorials in each term. If they do not fulfil this requirement, they will not be allowed to attempt the XI final examination.
- Get their journals (in whichever subject practical are held) certified by the concerned teacher.
- Secure a minimum of 35 % on the average marks of the 1st and 2nd examination together with the Unit Tests in each subject.
- Students who cannot attempt the 1st or 2nd term exams on medical grounds or for genuine reasons which have been accepted by the Principal / Vice-Principal will have to appear for the supplementary examinations.

2. No supplementary examinations will be held for Std. XII students.

3. No supplementary Unit Tests will be held for Std. XI students.

4. Students of S.Y.J.C. (Commerce and Science) will not be granted terms unless they fulfil the following conditions:

- Attend at least 75 % of the lectures, practical and tutorials in each term.
- Ensure that their journals are (in whichever subject practical are held) certified by the concerned teacher.
- Both F.Y.J.C. & S.Y.J.C. students submit their E.V.S. projects within the schedule announced by the concerned teacher, or else they will be marked zero. Subsequently, such students will be detained in the same class.
- Make sure that their performance at the two terminal examinations is satisfactorily handled.

5. Absence for Medical or other Valid Reasons

- No student can remain absent from lectures, practical, unit test or terminal examinations without the explicit permission of the Principal. If a student is absent without permission, disciplinary action (including denial of Terms) will be initiated by the College.
- Absence from any College Test / Examination must be justified in writing and in case of illness, by a Medical Certificate. These letters and Medical Certificates, accompanied by a covering letter from the Parent / Guardian of the student, must be submitted to the Principal by the last day of

the Examination / Test. Letters and Certificates to explain absence from Examinations / Tests must be submitted separately from those intended to explain absence from lectures / practical.

- Although illness or other serious circumstances may be considered valid reasons for absence from lectures, practicals, examinations, etc., the College may not have enough evidence of academic progress to grant the student terms for the year. The student would then have to repeat the course of studies in the following academic year. for (Junior College students only)

Rules and Code of Conduct of the College

The college expects every student to abide by the following Code of conduct:

- Identity Card:
 - a) Students must have their Identity Card duly filled in and signed. Students must wear their Identity Card when they are in the college premises.
 - b) Transfer of I. D. Cards is a criminal offence. The Student will be liable to expulsion from the college.
- Littering in the classrooms, corridors & the campus is prohibited. Please use the dustbins provided all around. Offenders will be penalized.
- Sitting on the vehicles in the college compound is strictly prohibited.
- Loitering or Crowding is also prohibited. Students are required to remain in the college campus during their free hours.
- Mobile phones, if carried by the students, should be switched off while in the classroom, library & corridors of the college. If these instructions are not followed, the instrument will be confiscated, and the concerned student will also be fined.
- Students must follow the rules and regulations laid down by the college authorities.
- Students are expected to take utmost care while handling/using the college property. Any damage caused shall make the student liable to recompensation or fine.
- The formation of any kind of group/association/committee, without the permission or authority of the Principal is strictly prohibited.
- The students are not supposed to get into any activities that can cause hindrance to the smooth functioning of the institute or result in disrupting the discipline of the college.
- It is essential for every student to reach the college on time, late comers shall be denied entry.
- No student can leave the premises during lectures. In case of long leave/absence, the student along with parents must personally meet the principal with proper documentation.
- Students are responsible for their own belongings. They must make sure they do not leave their belongings unattended.
- It is the responsibility of the students to check the notices and remember the instructions posted therein.
- Any student found using unfair means during examinations shall be adequately punished or can even be dismissed or debarred from the examinations.
- Using of foul language or misconduct in the college campus shall be treated severely.
- All the students are expected to dress modestly and maintain the sanctity of the institute.

ANTI-RAGGING RULES

Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college premises & outside. A student involved in any such act will be expelled from the college may undergo imprisonment and fine.

ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION IN THE EVENT OF RAGGING

The institution shall punish a student found guilty of ragging after following the procedure and in the manner prescribed herein under:

- b. Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits.
- c. Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or another evaluation process.
- d. Withholding results.
- e. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- f. Cancellation of admission.
- g. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- h. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION FOR USE OF UNFAIR MEANS BY STUDENT DURING EXAMINATION

VVUC has rigorous procedures in place to detect the instance of malpractices during examinations. Once reported potential malpractices to follow a process of investigation by the exam department.

To ensure honesty and fairness during the examinations and avoid any malpractice during examination Unfair means committee established in college is authorized to take disciplinary action against a student for misconduct during an examination conducted by the college. They can decide the quantum of punishment after reviewing the nature of malpractices at theory, practical / project report examination.

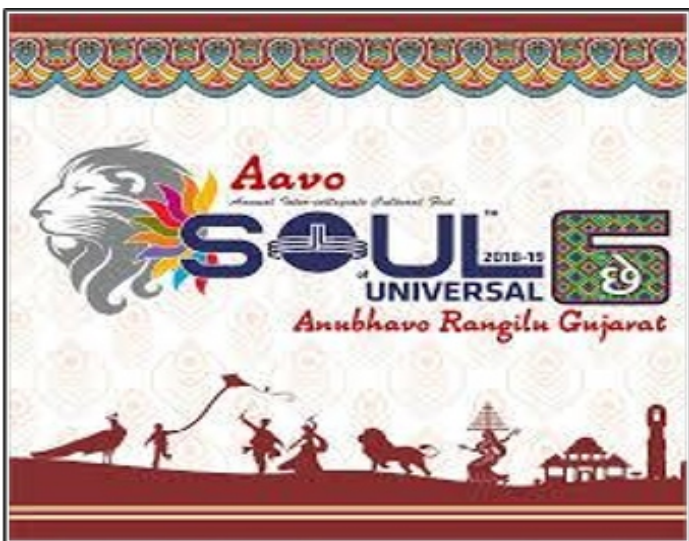
Commerce Fest

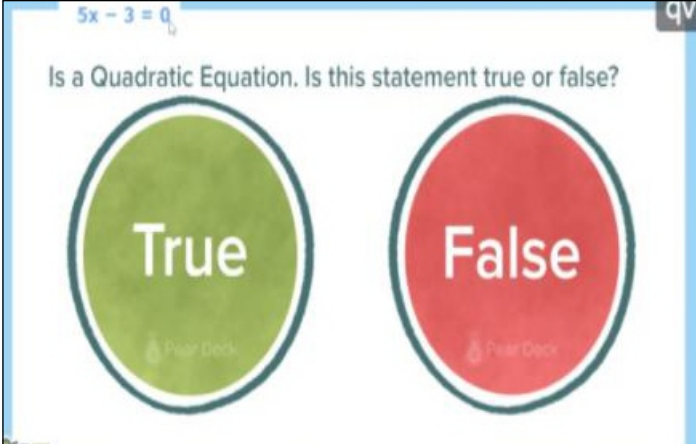
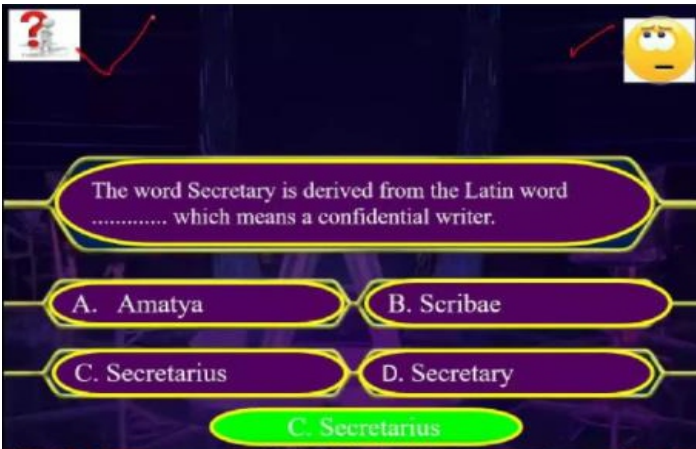
1. HSC LECTURES:
