Admission Information

Admission to the XI std. under the Gujarati Linguistic Minority Category will be done by the Management of the College at the level of the Principal as per the schedule declared by the Deputy Director of Education Office. For students seeking admission under the open, sports, cultural categories and other reservations, an online admission process is conducted by the Deputy Director of Education Office and the students are admitted as per the list sent by the Deputy Director of Education Office.

- Aadhar Card photocopy.
- 3 recent stamp size photographs.
- Attested true copy of the relevant documents

supporting the reservation (SPORTS, CULTURAL, etc.) is also required.

In addition to the above requirements, the students claiming admission under the Gujarati Linguistic Minority quota will have to submit the following:

- Marksheet/School leaving certificate indicating father or mother studied in Gujarati Medium.

OR

- A stamped letter on the letterhead of the community Head or Secretary signed by the President.

OR

- Vasti Patrak of the community where the name of the applicant appears along with his/her parent's name.

Documents required for the Provisional Eligibility Certificate for students coming from

boards other than the Maharashtra State Board:

- Application in the prescribed form which is obtained from the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Education, Mumbai, Divisional Board, Navi Mumbai, Vashi - 400 703.
- Statement of Marks and 3 attested true copies of the same.
- Leaving Certificate (countersigned by the educational inspector) and 3 attested true copies of the same.
- Migration Certificate.
- Need of Undertaking on Rs. 20/- stamp paper. Specimen copy of the matter which is to be typed on stamp paper given in the application form.

Recommendation Letter

Students applying to various universities abroad can apply for a letter of recommendation at the office in advance.

Necessary documents required

- Online application forms on the website from the student for availing the Transcript Forms.
- Attested copy of the marksheets.
- Attested photocopy of Leaving Certificate.

Bonafide Certificate

Students with genuine reason can apply for a Bonafide certificate to the college. Students may contact the information counter to apply for a Bonafide certificate. Charge for issuing the Bonafide certificate is Rs. 100/-. Students can collect the certificate within two working days from the information counter.

Necessary documents required:

- Online application forms on the website from the student.
- Photocopy of leaving certificate.
- Attested copy of the marksheets.
- Photocopy of identity card.

No Objection Certificate

Students with the need of NOC in case of change of board, university, or is applying for a passport can apply at the office. The certificate will be provided within 10-15 days at the information counter.

Necessary documents required:

- Online application forms on the website from the student for availing the Transcript Forms.
- Photocopy of leaving certificate.
- Attested copy of the marksheets.
- Photocopy of identity card.

Leaving Certificate

Leaving certificate is provided to the students after 12th along with their mark sheets. If a student wants leaving certificate after 11th he/she needs to apply for the same at the office.

Online application forms on the website from the students.

- Attested copy of the mark sheets.
- Photocopy of identity card.

Rules and Code of Conduct of the College

Attendance for Learners

Every student is required to maintain a minimum of 75% attendance separately for lectures, tutorials and/or practical conducted for each semester / term, failing which the terms will not be granted, and the student cannot appear for the term end and/or annual examination conducted by the college on behalf of the University / Board or by the University or by the Maharashtra Board.

On-campus Conduct

1. Every student must obtain on admission, the identity card which must have his/her photograph attested and wears the identity card on a person whenever he/she is on the college premises and present it for inspection on demand.
2. If the academic performance of the student is not satisfactory, the student is likely to be detained and will not be allowed to appear for the examinations conducted by the college on behalf of the University/Board or by the University of Mumbai or Maharashtra Board.
3. Students must be present in the college premises on time, late comers will not be tolerated. Students must not loiter in the college premises while the classes are going on.
4. In case of absence on account of illness, the Principal should be informed by the parents personally. On resuming the college, the student should report to the Principal along with the fitness certificate.
5. Students must not attend classes other than their own, without the permission of the Principal.
6. Smoking and consumption of alcohol in the college premises or entering the college premises, after consuming alcoholic drinks is strictly prohibited.
7. Students shall do nothing either inside or outside the college that will in any way interfere with its orderly conduct and discipline.
8. No Society or Association shall be formed in the college and no person will be invited to address a meeting without the Principal's prior permission.
9. No student shall collect any money or contribution for picnic, trip, educational visit to some place, get-together, study- notes, charity or any other activity without prior sanction of the Principal.
10. No student will be allowed to take active part in current politics.
11. No student shall communicate any information or write about matters dealing with the college administration to the Press.
12. Students are expected to take proper care of college property and help the college authorities in keeping the premises clean. Damaging college property, e.g. disfiguring walls, doors, fittings or breaking furniture, misuse of fittings, or breaking furniture, misuse of A.C. etc., is breach of discipline, and the guilty will be duly punished.
13. Students should not leave their books, valuables and other belongings in the classroom.

14. The college is not responsible for loss of property. However, Student may make a claim for lost property at the office, if it is deposited in the college office.

15. Students applying for certificates, testimonials, etc. which require the Principal's signature on any kind of document or application should first contact the college office. Students should not bring any paper directly to the Principal for his/her signature.

16. If, in the opinion of the Principal, for any reason, the continuance of a student in the college is detrimental to the best interest of the college, the Principal may ask such a student to leave the college without assigning reason for his/her decision.

17. Students joining the college shall be governed by the rules and regulations of the college.

18. Insubordination and unbecoming language or misconduct on the part of a student are sufficient reasons for his/her suspension or dismissal.

19. Students receiving Government or college Scholarships or any remission in fees, must note that the grant and continuance thereof are subject to good behaviour, regular attendance and satisfactory progress and good results at the college and Board Examinations.

20. All college activities are organized under the guidance and supervision of the Principal and Teacher in-charge.

21. Students must not associate themselves with any activity unauthorized by the college

Principal. Stringent action will be taken against students found organizing or participating in such unauthorized activities.

22. Students using unfair means at examinations will not be readmitted to the college. Actions will be initiated against such students as per the norms and procedure prescribed by the University of Mumbai or by the Maharashtra Board.

23. It is the responsibility of the students to read the notice boards regularly for important announcements made by the college office from time to time. They will not be excused or given any concession on grounds of ignorance or not reading notices.

24. Use of mobile phones and handheld devices are not allowed on campus. If a student is found using the same, then his mobile phone shall be confiscated and shall be returned only at the end of the academic year, i.e. 30th April of the academic year.

25. The matters not covered by the existing rules will rest at the absolute discretion of the Principal.

Dress Code

At Vidya Vikas Universal Junior College, we believe in ensuring that the sanctity of educational institution is maintained and leave the concept of dress code to the able and thoughtful sense of the students who are well aware of the fact that the students are entering an educational institution.

Anti-Ragging Rules

Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college premises & outside. A student involved in any such act will be expelled from the college may undergo imprisonment and fine.

ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION IN THE EVENT OF RAGGING

The institution shall punish a student found guilty of ragging after following the procedure and in the manner prescribed herein under:

- a. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- b. Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits.
- c. Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or another evaluation process.
- d. Withholding results.
- e. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- f. Cancellation of admission.
- g. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- h. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION FOR USE OF UNFAIR MEANS DURING EXAMINATION

Vidya Vikas Universal College (VVUC) maintains strict procedures to prevent and detect any form of malpractice during examinations. If any instance of suspected unfair means is reported, the matter is carefully investigated by the Examination Department.

To ensure honesty, transparency, and fairness in examinations, the college has constituted an Unfair Means Committee. This committee is authorized to review cases of misconduct during theory, practical, or project examinations conducted by the college. After examining the nature and seriousness of the malpractice, the committee decides the appropriate disciplinary action or punishment as per the college rules.

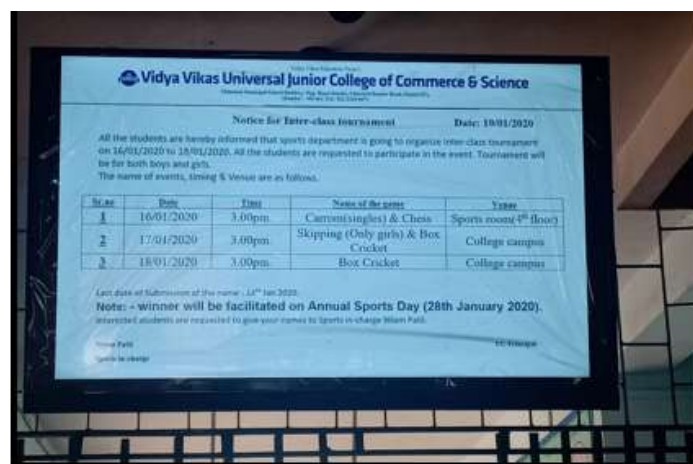

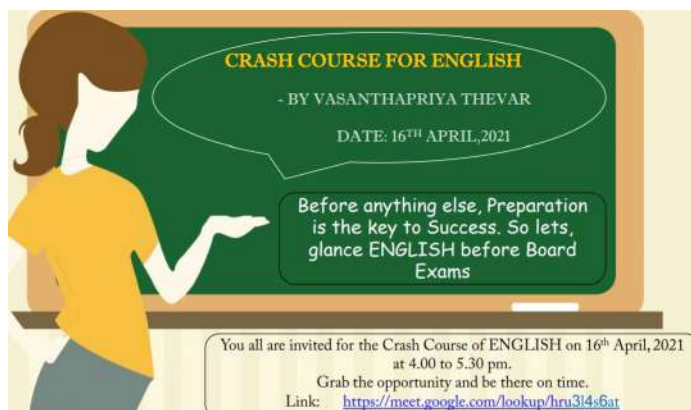

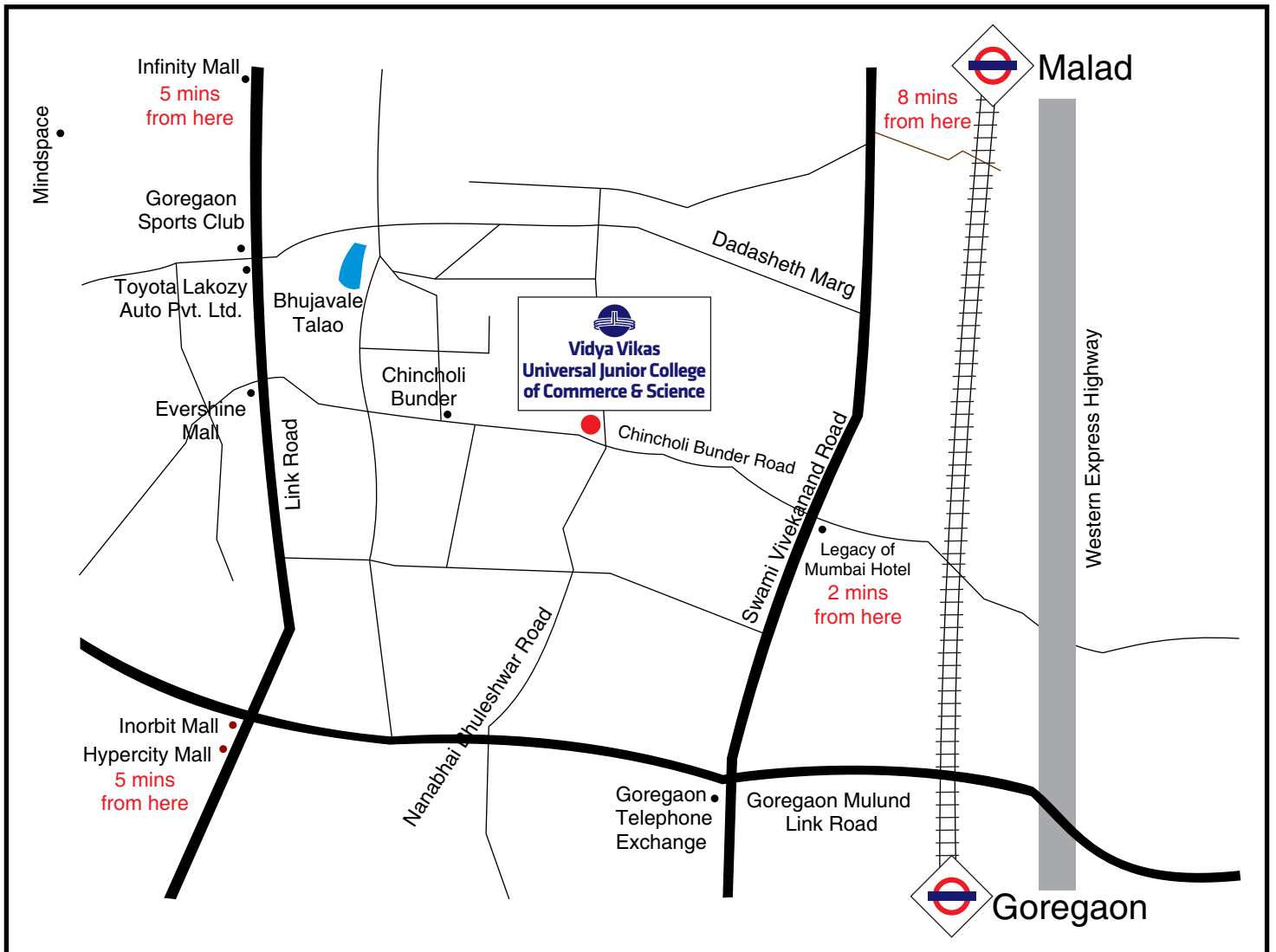
